



1- Reading of Lutefisk Sushi B's bento box contents.


2- Luke has volunteered to plaster St. Cloud with flyers to announce our next meeting and hopefully getting more folks to attends. Thank you!



Most of the work we produced on March ended up being used for commercial purposes, but here's two sketches for your viewing enjoyment. :D






The May Meeting was hampered by an outbreak of the flu...
